

Process of Ethical Clearance for Students

As part of the AcSIR-NIScPR PhD procedure, students conducting data collection and field surveys must obtain ethical clearance from the Ethics and Scientific Vigilance Committee (SEC). It has been noted that students are bypassing the Head, AcSIR, CSIR-NIScPR when applying for this clearance and submitting to the committee directly. Therefore, it is directed that all such applications for ethical clearance be routed through the Head, AcSIR.
